Topics that will be of interest to members may include: Cross-disciplinary and inter-disciplinary programs and degrees; Alignment of degree outcomes and workplace expectations; Partnering to drive institutional change to support graduate education; Role of Graduate Colleges in facilitating inclusion of diverse viewpoints and experiences in an age of dissent; Team-based pedagogical strategies in doctoral and clinical professional education; Inter-institutional and community partners, alliances and consortia and more.

- 1. Description:** No more than 300 words describing the proposed session
- 2. Abstract:** Fifty word abstract for inclusion in the program should the session be accepted
- 3. Presenter Contact Information:**

 - Name, affiliation, email address, and telephone number of other presenter(s)²

NOTE: Priority Deadline for Submissions is Friday June 23, 2017.

Abstracts will be reviewed at the June meeting of the Executive Committee, and notifications will be sent by July 31, 2017.
